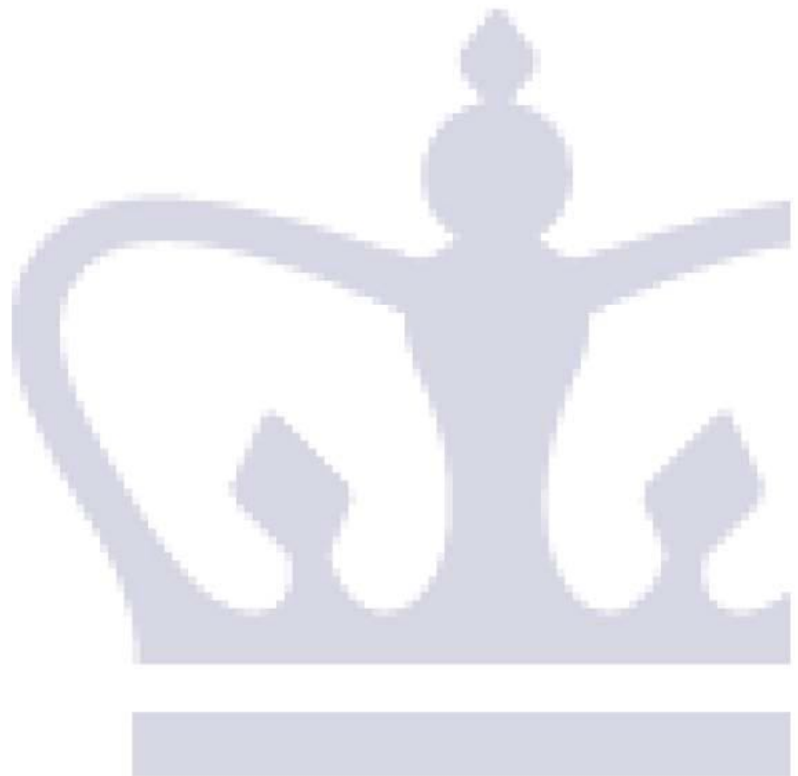

## Program Description & Objectives


